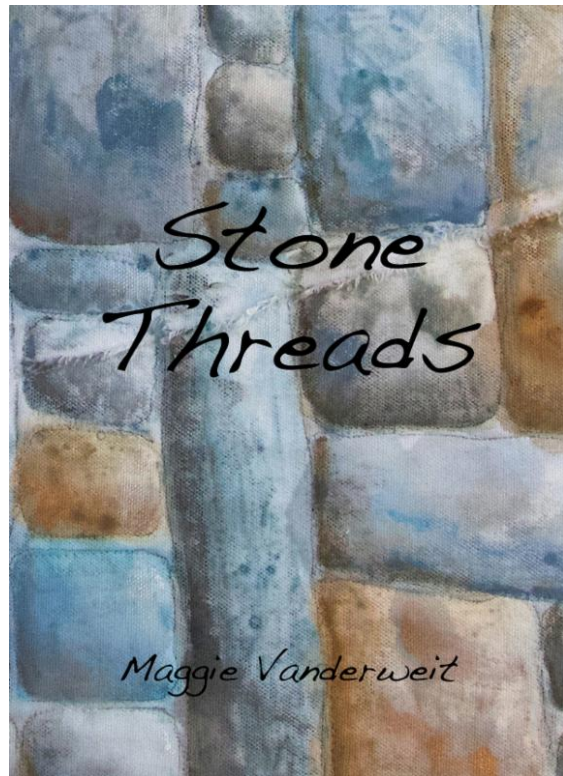

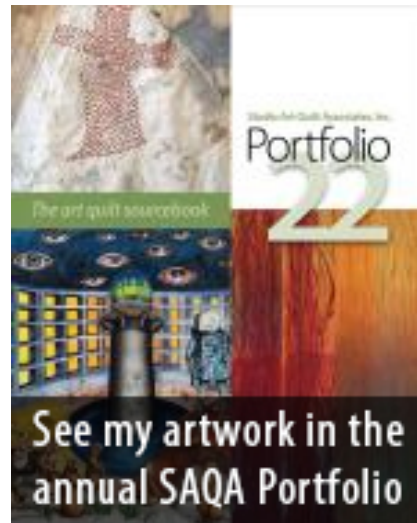

international conference!



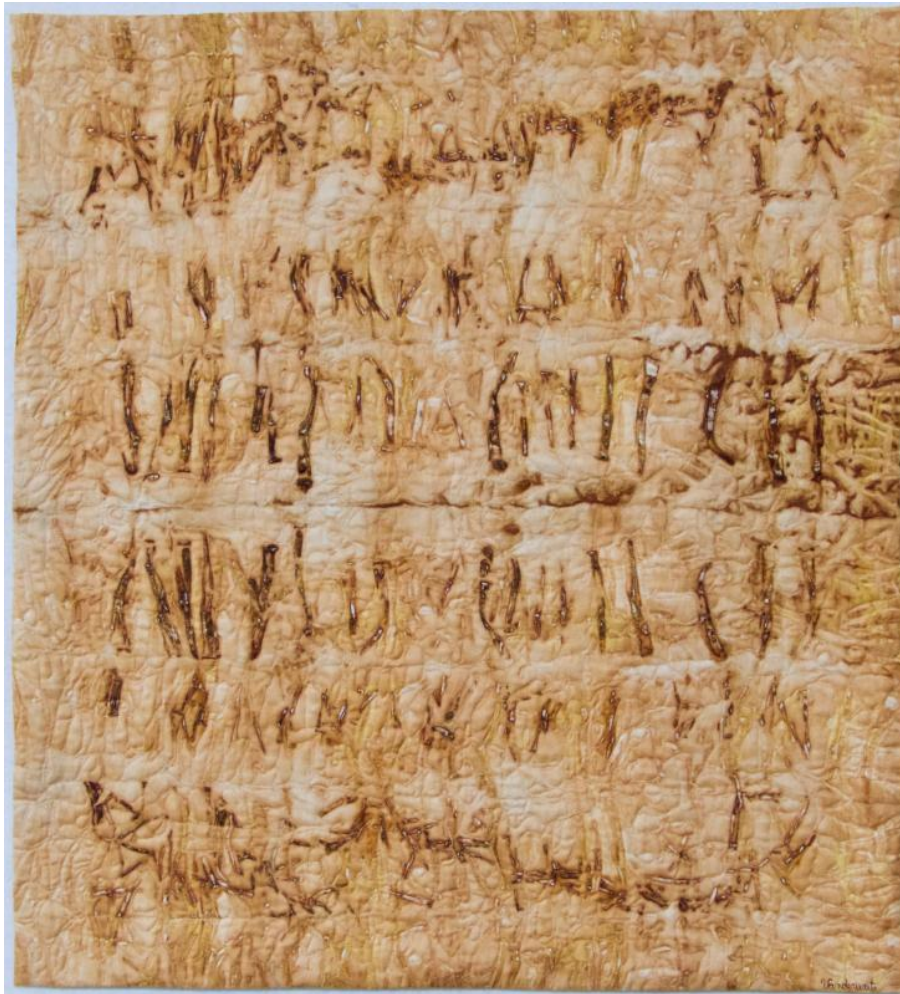
